#### PRACTICAL INFORMATION

#### 1. ACCOMODATION

Rooms have been reserved at the <u>NH Collection Copenhagen</u> in Copenhagen (Strandgade 7, 1401 Copenhagen).

When arriving at Copenhagen airport, take <u>metro line number 2</u> (Lufthavnen-Christianshavn) to the meeting venue. The "NH Collection Copenhagen" is 300 m away from the metro station Christianshavn.

The price of the rooms amounts to 1.555 DKK per room and per night for a single occupancy (i.e. around 208 euro), VAT, city tax and breakfast included. For a double room the price amounts to 1.700 DKK (i.e. around 228 euro).

We book the rooms for the participants (see <u>registration form</u>). Participants are kindly requested to pay directly the hotel for their rooms when they leave the hotel at the end of their stay.

Please note that <u>after 14 February</u> it will no longer be possible to cancel a room booking without incurring a fee. In this case <u>YOU WILL HAVE TO PAY FOR THE ROOM ANYWAY</u>.

### 2. PARTICIPATION FEE

The participation fee, which amount to **250 euro per participant**, aim to cover the costs of Independent Retail Europe for the organisation of this event (meeting room, lunch, etc.).
